We should have 2 rally points instead of 4 to avoid confusion What we're currently doing clearly isn't working

Keep the current rally point but since Manchester Rd. is so busy quickly get off onto the side roads

The problem is we need ride organizers . . . only 9 unique people led rides this year.

The Ride Committee will be responsible for making sure there is a ride each week.

People will just come out for the Sunday rides when the week's rally point is near their home.

We won't know until we try, the new ideas may fail or need to be modified throughout the season.

Dave Kelewea said Jim Stiebel, Scott, and he were already doing test rides and had done 3 in the past week.

Membership Jim Gianella reported we have no new members this month, total membership stands at 88.

Tony Weaver reported the club brought in \$134 over the past month and spent \$10.78 for newsletter expenses.

A motion was made seconded and approved for Tony to write a check for \$318.20 to Hartbauer McBride for the dispersal of charity funds in our account

Jim Craig will be running for Club Secretary and Scott Lenahan will be running for Vice President in the upcoming January election of officers.
