I'm going to harp about tires again: it's not only about tire pressure it's about tire condition. If you have a small bad spot on one of your tires it will grow at an alarming rate when you ride. Once that outer layer of rubber starts to do it deteriorates pretty quickly. I just got a new Dunlop, and haven't had a chance to ride before last Sunday to break it in. If the roads had been wet like predicted I would have possibly been in some trouble. For those of you who don't buy tires very often never forget about the coating that is put on tires at the factory for preservation purposes. It's a little slick until your able to rough the tire up a little. If the pavement is wet it's like riding on wet painted road stripes. Never forget to get that protective coating off before riding aggressively. Your paint job will be glad you did!

We ate at the Cliff House Inn on our first full day there and the food and the view was incredible. Hanging out over the Arkansas Grand Canyon it is a view that you never forget. Sitting out on the balcony in a rocking chair surrounded by humming bird feeders and looking down on soaring birds of prey is a picture to be had.

We rode many of our favorite roads while we were there. We didn't make it to Turner's Bend due to my route directions being off by one turn. But the rides were still fun. We stopped at a little eatery in the middle of nowhere known as Sugar Booger's Bar-B-Que. 
