Shadow Riders,

It's starting to look a lot like Spring! Time to get ready to RUMBLE.

Something that we've been noticing more and more these last several years is unusual tire tread wear. Be sure to check your tires before heading out. Check that owner's manual for the recommended pressure for your particular machine and also give the tires a spin to check your tread all the way around. I had one tire on the front of the Triumph that had one small patch of uneven tread but the rest of the tire looked pretty healthy still. That small patch was a warning sign that I didn't heed and I bought a new tire in Arkansas after only riding about 300 miles more. I had a bald patch 2 inches wide all the way around the tire when I got to Arkansas. Look for flaws and defects. They do happen.

With that being said, please be careful and take it easy on your first few trips out in the Spring. Even experienced riders know that each new season deserves a little care when you haven't been in the saddle for several months. Just be careful: we hate to hear that one of our friends have taken a fall.
